Important Notes for Participants

1. Seminar Capacity

Applicants are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications will close once the maximum number of participants for the seminar has been reached.

2. Changes to Seminar

Please note that you may not make any changes to the seminar you have applied for once your application has been submitted.

3. Seminar Attire

Please ensure that you are properly attired in your uniform when attending the seminar.

Men are not allowed to wear T-shirts under their uniforms. Women are allowed to wear plain white T-shirts under their uniforms but not other kinds of clothing. In addition, both men and women are not allowed to wear any watches, accessories, bandanas, etc.

4. Eligibility for Certificate of Completion

Participants must attend all 4 days of the seminar, excluding bus tours, to receive a certificate of completion.

5. No Food and Drinks in the Dojo

No food and drinks are allowed in the Dojo, which will be the seminar venue. Please hydrate yourself in the lobby or at the seats and have your lunch at the designated lunch venue.

6. ID Pass

Please remember to bring along your personal ID card that will be issued to you during registration on the first day for the entire duration of the seminar.

7. Handling of Valuables

8. Photography and Video-taking
